### Introduction:

#### TOUR SUMMARY

This tour to Egypt is one of the top requested Egypt travel packages because it covers different tour activities, including visit to Pyramids, Nile Cruise, Hurghada and Alexandria as well. A similar package is highly requested by our dear guests who would like to have an exceptional holiday in Egypt with different activities and tour options.

We start this tour to Egypt with the awesome monuments of Cairo, including the Pyramids of Giza, the rich site of Saqqara, the ancient city of Memphis, the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities, the Citadel of Salah El Din, the Coptic Cairo Area and the well-known old market of Khan El Khalili.

Afterwards, we will transfer our dear guests to Cairo International Airport, in order to catch their domestic flight to Aswan, so they can embark their five-star Nile Cruise ship on the same day!

The regular Nile Cruise program usually includes visits to the High Dam, the Temple of Philae, the Unfinished Obelisk, the Temple of Kom Ombo, the Temple of Edfu, the Valley of the Kings, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut, the Colossi of Memnon, the Karnak Temples Complex and the Temple of Luxor. This is besides offering many optional tours and additional excursions like a Sound & Light Show, Felucca Ride around the awesome islands and a hot air balloon adventure over the west bank of Luxor.

After the Nile Cruise adventure, we will drive by an air-conditioned vehicle from the city of Luxor to the coastal city of Hurghada, so our dear guests can take some rest of the sandy beaches of Hurghada after spending few days exploring the classical tourist sites in Cairo, Aswan and Luxor.

The last part of our lovely vacation in Egypt will be in Alexandria, where we include many attractive visits to the unique Greco-Roman collection covering the Catacombs of Kom El Shoqafa, the Roman Amphitheatre and the Pompey's Pillar. This is besides visiting the Bibliotheca of Alexandria and the Qaitbay Fort.

## Detailed Itinerary:

### DAY BY DAY PROGRAM

#### Day 01: Wednesday "Arrival to Egypt"

Upon arrival to Cairo International Airport, you will be met by our English-speaking representative, who will help you in all formalities at the airport like passing the passport control and collecting your luggage. Then, you will be transferred to the hotel in Cairo by private Air-conditioned vehicle. We will check in the hotel within few minutes! The rest of the day is FREE at leisure on your own in Cairo, where we can offer you various OPTIONAL tours that enable you to explore this marvelous city by night. [No Meals]

#### Day 02: Thursday "Cairo Pyramids Tour"

Energizing breakfast at your hotel. After that, you will be met by our expert, Egyptologist tour guide, who will join you in such awe-inspiring tour to visit **Pyramids of Giza**, constructed around 2500 BC as the necropolis of the kings of the fourth dynasty. We will then proceed to Sakkara to visit **The Step Pyramid Complex**, which is considered to be the oldest surviving stone monument in the whole world. We will then have a short break for lunch at local restaurant in Cairo. Our last visit will be to **The Open-Air Museum** in Memphis, which was established in the 32nd century BC by King Narmer after he unified Upper and Lower Egypt and became the first capital of the whole country. After that, we will transfer you back to your hotel for rest & refresh. The remainder of the day is FREE at leisure on your own. Overnight in Cairo. [Breakfast & Lunch]



### Day 03: Friday "Aswan Classic Tour"

Early check out from your hotel. Later on, you'll be met by our representative in Cairo, who will transfer you to Cairo Airport, to catch your domestic flight to Aswan. Upon arrival, you'll be met by our local representative in Aswan, who will transfer you to your five-star Nile Cruise boat. After lunch, we will start our city tour in Aswan by visiting the **High Dam**, originally constructed to store the water and then generate electricity. Later on, we will ride a motorboat to Agilika Island, where we will visit **Temple of Philae**, constructed in the 3rd century BC in the Greco Roman period and was dedicated to goddess Isis, mother of Horus. At the end of our city tour in Aswan, we will visit the **Unfinished Obelisk**, if completed, it would have been the largest piece of stone humans ever dealt with. After the tour, we will transfer you back to your Nile Cruise ship for rest & refresh. The remainder of the day is FREE at leisure on your own in Aswan, however, we can offer you wonderful "Optional" tour to attend the Sound & Light Show at Philae Temple. Overnight in Aswan. [Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner]

### Day 04: Saturday "Kom Ombo & Edfu"

Energizing breakfast on board before our full day tour. Our Nile Cruise ship will land at the location of the city of Kom Ombo to visit **Temple of Sobek & Haroeris**, which was established in the Ptolemaic period and completed in the Roman era and was dedicated to two gods, Sobek and Haroeris. After that, we will get back to our boat for Lunch. Arrange yourself for the second visit of the day to **Temple of Horus in Edfu**, the finest preserved ancient Egyptian temple in the land of the Nile. After that, we will return to our Nile Cruise ship for rest and refresh. Evening time is free at leisure on your own on board, so you can enjoy the oriental show that will be operated by staff. Dinner and overnight on board. [Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner]

## Day 05: Sunday "West Bank of Luxor"

Morning time is free at leisure on your own in Luxor, where we can offer "optional tour" to try the Hot Air Balloon over the West Bank of Luxor. After breakfast, we will explore the **Valley of the Kings**, the richest and most fascinating ancient tombs in Egypt. This was the burial site of the kings from the New Kingdom. The next visit of the day will be to the impressive **Temple of Deir El Bahari**, constructed during the reign of the 18th dynasty by Queen Hatshepsut, one of the greatest rulers of Egypt. We will then visit the **Colossi of Memnon**; these two huge statues are the only remaining items of the great funerary temple of Amenhotep III constructed in 1350 BC and became a landmark of Luxor afterwards. After this marvelous tour, we will transfer you back to your Nile Cruise to have some rest. The remainder of the day is FREE at leisure on your own to explore the beaten tracks of Luxor. Dinner & overnight on board the Nile Cruise. [Breakfast, Lunch & Dinner]

## Day 06: Monday "East Bank of Luxor"

Enjoy your breakfast on board before exploring the east bank of Luxor including two marvelous temple complexes. Our first visit of the day will be to **Karnak Temples Complex**, almost all the impressive items of the Karnak we see today date back to the new kingdom specially the huge amazing columns of the hypostyle hall, which are constructed by the famous king, Ramses II. We will then visit the **Temple of Luxor**, which was established around the 14th century BC and the construction continued for many years afterwards by Ramses II, Queen Hatshepsut, and many other Pharaohs. After the tour, we will drive by a late model, Air-conditioned, vehicle towards the city of Hurghada. The distance between Luxor & Hurghada is about 300 KM, takes about 04 hours by car. Arrive to Hurghada, check-in and overnight at your hotel. [Breakfast]

### Day 07: Tuesday "FREE day at leisure in Hurghada"

The rest of the day is FREE morning in Hurghada, where you can enjoy the amazing view of the Red Sea. The guests have the chance to go for an optional BBQ Dinner with Bedouin party in the desert mood, enjoy Bedouin music, and share dances with your partner and friends. Hurghada has all what a tourist might think about including nightspots including restaurants, cafes, discos, bars, shops, and various stores and different types of entertainment. The rest of the day is free at leisure on your own in Hurghada. You can also enjoy a safe walking tour in the coastal city of Hurghada or enjoy the entertainment activities at your hotel – available upon request, BUT, sometimes subject to extra charge, so please double check with us before you go. Overnight in Hurghada. [Breakfast]

### Day 08: Wednesday "FREE day at leisure in Hurghada"

You can also go on an "optional" Sindbad Submarine tour, where you can view the wonders of the red sea from a modern equipped glass boat for a ride that is always memorable. At night, Hurghada has all what a tourist might think about including nightspots including restaurants, cafes, discos, bars, shops, and various stores and different types of entertainment. You can also enjoy a safe walking tour in the coastal city of Hurghada or enjoy the entertainment activities at your hotel – available upon your request, BUT, sometimes subject to extra charge, so please double check with us before you go. Overnight in Hurghada. [Breakfast]

## Day 09: Thursday "Cairo City Tour"

Check out after breakfast. Later on, you'll be met by our local representative in Hurghada, who will transfer you by private Air-conditioned vehicle to Hurghada Airport in order to catch your flight to Cairo. Upon arrival to Cairo International Airport, you'll be met by our representative, who will help & assist you in all formalities at the airport. Later on, you'll join our tour guide on a city tour, including the **Egyptian Museum**, the largest museum in the world with a huge collection of displays dating back to various periods of the ancient Egyptian history. We will then visit the **Citadel of Saladin**, constructed in the 10th century by Saladin to protect Egypt and became the residence of Egypt's rulers for more than seven centuries. At the end of the tour and before we get back to our hotel, we will visit the **Coptic Cairo Area**, including the Hanging Church and the church of Abu Serga. After the tour, we will transfer you back to your hotel for rest & refresh. The remainder of the day is FREE at leisure on your own to explore Cairo by night! Overnight in Cairo. [Breakfast & Lunch]



## Day 10: Friday "Alexandria Tour from Cairo"

Our first visit will be to the historical **Library of Alexandria**, with the ancient library being established in the 3rd century BC and destroyed in the 1st century BC. We will then visit the **Roman Amphitheatre**, discovered in 1960, the theatre which was established in the 4th century BC with its marble steps is one of its kind in Egypt. We will then have our lunch meal at local restaurant. After lunch, we will visit **Qaitbay Citadel**, this citadel was established in the 16th century and became the landmark of Alexandria today. After this amazing tour in Cairo, we will drive back to your hotel in Cairo for overnight. [Breakfast & Lunch]
