07 NIGHTS CRUISE EX. LUXOR

Day 01: Saturday "Arrival to Luxor, Check in & FREE at leisure"

Upon arrival to Luxor International Airport, you'll be met by our English-speaking representative, who will help and assist you in all formalities, collecting your luggage, etc. Later on, you'll be transferred by private Airconditioned vehicle to your Nile Cruise boat. On our return way to the cruise, we will visit the Colossi of Memnon, the only remaining items of the great funerary temple of king Amenhotep III. Overnight on board.
